

Town of Franklin
Ordinance on the Establishment of the Procedure
for the Election of Members to the
Planning & Zoning Commission

Pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes Chapter 124 & 126, the Town of Franklin hereby amends its 1974 Ordinance on the Creation of the Planning & Zoning Commission to read as follows:

SECTION I: The Planning & Zoning Commission shall consist of five members and three alternates. The members of the Commission at the time of the adoption of this ordinance shall continue in office until their terms would otherwise have expired. Within thirty days after the effective date of this ordinance, the Board of Selectmen shall appoint three alternates to serve until replaced by alternates elected for a four-year term. Members and alternates shall thereafter be elected to a four-year terms as follows:

- at the 1985 election, three members and two alternates
- at the 1987 election, two members and one alternate
- and thereafter, according to the same pattern

Vacancies occurring among the members or the alternates shall be filled by the Board of Selectmen until the next regular municipal election.

SECTION II: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION III: All parts of the 1974 Ordinance on the Creation of the Planning & Zoning Commission not incorporated herein are hereby repealed. The 1971 Ordinance on Planning is also repealed.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and after notice as provided by law.
