Town of Franklin Ordinance on the Establishment of Regional Animal Control Services

As per Section 22-331a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any two or more contiguous towns, each of which has a population of less than 25,000, may agree to be served by regional animal control services by action of their legislative bodies. Accordingly, the Town of Franklin hereby authorizes the First Selectman to establish regional animal control services and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Towns of Bozrah, Lebanon, and Sprague for a term from July 1st, 2010 to June 30th, 2015. Additionally, the Town of Franklin hereby authorizes the First Selectman to enter into a revised Memorandum of Understanding if other towns desire to participate in these services in the future.

If any part of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, such determination shall not affect the validity of any other part, and the rest of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
