Town of Franklin Ordinance on the Tax Assessor

Be it hereby ordained as follows by town meeting of the Town of Franklin:

SECTION I:

- A) There shall be one Tax Assessor for the Town of Franklin, whose appointment and term of office shall be made by the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Franklin, as provided for by Section 9-198 of the Connecticut General Statutes.
- B) The Tax Assessor shall be a Certified Connecticut Municipal Assessor, as provided for by Section 12-40a of the Connecticut General Statutes.
- C) The term for said Tax Assessor shall commence on July 1st, 1991.

SECTION II: Said Board of Selectmen shall also have the authority to establish the compensation for the Tax Assessor and to authorize the Tax Assessor to have clerical assistance, as provided for by Section 9-198 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

SECTION III: Once the Tax Assessor has commenced his/her term of office, the terms of Assessors then in the office shall terminate, as provided for by Section 9-198 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

SECTION IV: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION V: All ordinances, acts, resolutions, and parts of ordinances, acts, and resolutions previously adopted for the Town of Franklin, which are in conflict herein, are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and after notice as provided by law.
