WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PLAN – FRANKLIN SWAMP WMA: The Agriculture and Conservation Commission for the Town of Franklin, AgCon, recently received the Draft Copy of the Wildlife Management Plan for the Franklin Swamp WMA.

Susan Allen provided a letter, on behalf of AgCon, to the Franklin Swamp Wildlife Management Area, Eastern District Area Headquarters, Department of Environmental Protection, State of Connecticut, dated December 3, 2020, regarding their input and comments outlined as *General Comment and Observations, Specifics, and Mutually Beneficial section*.

AgCon supports the proposed plan and expresses gratitude for being included in this process and is looking forward to a continued symbiotic relationship with Franklin Swamp WMA.

Tanner Steeves, DEEP Wildlife Division Biologist, Ann Kilpatrick DEEP Wildlife Division Biologist, Kelly Kubik, DEEP Wildlife Division Waterfowl and Migratory Bird Biologist, and Dan Evans State of CT Forester were present. It was explained DEEP is trying to create a breeding area for American Woodcock at Franklin Swamp among other objectives. The draft report stemmed from DEEP revisiting various state-owned properties and Franklin Swamp needed an updated inventory of lands and species. Lastly, they responded to comments and concerns and points of interest outlined in the above mentioned AgCon letter.
