 - b. **Monthly Board of Selectmen Income Report**: Mr. Grant reviewed the most current report as submitted at the meeting. State funds have not been received by the Town at this point.
 - c. **Monthly Board of Selectmen Expense Report**: Mr. Grant reviewed the most current report as submitted at the meeting. Acounts are where they should be and range from 3% to 4 % expended. There are a small amount of outstanding bills to be paid from FY 17-18. A final report will be provided when FY 17-18 is closed-out.
 - d. **Monthly Board of Education Report**: Peter Calvert indicated the BOE FY 17-18 budget will be in the black at close out.

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e. **Monthly Selectman's Report**: Mr. Grant reviewed the Town Budget as submitted at the meeting. Planning is taking place for the Plains Road Culvert Re-lining Project. Because of recent weather conditions, chip sealing of town roads will be done spring of 2019. Underground Storage Tank Replacement Project at Franklin Elementary School will be done summer of 2019. The Town and the Board of Education will work cooperatively to assure all preparation work is completed to allow for construction.
