a. **IWWC #18-01 Greg Allen:** New Subdivision Site Plan Review for property located at 31 Pond Rd, Assessor's Map 23, Lot 85, Zoned R-80. Existing use of property is a single family residential dwelling situated on 80 acres. Proposed activity is a one lot subdivision with the creation of a rear lot for construction of a single family dwelling

Discussion took place about the man made pond and its close proximity to the driveway. The existing pond is very small and considered a duck pond. There is an existing 10" culvert pipe that comes from the center of the pond and runs underneath the driveway. This was installed because the slope of the property runs downward towards the pond and driveway.

The applicant is proposing to fill in the pond and install a new 12" culvert pipe under the driveway including a riprap system around the area.
