IWWC 22-03 SOUND PETROLEUM: New Site Plan Review for Regulated Activities; Property located at 532 Pond Road, Assessors Map 53, Lot 12-45; Existing use of property is vacant land, proposed is propane storage tanks, detention basin & outlet, wet pond & outlet, filling & excavation w/in 50' upland review area. No direct impacts in wetlands.

**APPLICANT / PRESENTATION:** Wes Wentworth was present and reviewed Application materials as submitted. Site Plan reviewed dated 01.21.22. Stormwater Management Report reviewed dated 02.23.22.

**IWWC REVIEW**: Discussed (not limited to) locations of the pad for above ground propane storage tanks in proximity to wetlands, concerns of pollution from potential spill with storage tanks, railroad spur construction area, function of systems for receiving materials & offloading material into trucks, storm water-management plan, wet-pond with dry hydrants, and erosion and sedimentation plan. There was consensus the Towns' Consulting Engineer, Towne Engineering, review application materials.

c. IWWC 22-04 AARON NASH: Revised Site Plan Review for Regulated Activities; Property located at 16 Kahn Rd., Assessors Map 34, Lot 10; Existing use of property is residential, proposed is construction of 960 sq. ft. out building with concrete foundation.

**APPLICANT / PRESENTATION:** Mr. Nash reviewed application materials as presented including site plan dated 3.4.22. Building is to be used as storage workshop with electrical only.

**IWWC AGENT COMMENTS:** Wetlands are higher in elevation away from activity within a wooded area. Proposed activities and location will have no impact to wetlands.
