5. Report Wetlands Official:

**FRANKLIN HILLS GOLF COURSE:** Boundaries indicated erosion and sedimentation has taken hold and site is stabilized. Algonquin Gas Company property access along gas line is being torn-up by dirt bikes, quads, and jeep vehicles resulting in erosion issues. Property manager Sam Giavara will be contacted by Town of Franklin Staff to schedule site visit to discuss on-going issue of trespassers with recreation vehicles illegally entering the site. There is the possibility of installing fencing/gate and placing large boulders to eliminate entrance in problem areas. Responsibility of working to correct this issue is with property owner/representative.

**DOLLAR GENERAL**: While digging in preparation of installation retaining wall contractor left 2 trees with exposed root structures. Trees are now weak and must be taken down. Contractor agreed to replace weak trees with new healthy trees. Ron Chalecki gave permission for contractor to work outside limits of clearing for tree replacement only.

  - a. Review IWWC By-Laws: Commission members have been reviewing example by-laws from surrounding towns such as Sprague, Bozrah and Colchester, as well as related State Statutes and Town Ordinance.
