- Rich H reported that he had met with a contractor regarding the SLBB field. The initial estimate to create a true multi-use field totaled \$49,000. This has been discussed with the First Selectman with an eye on asking the BOF to reallocate existing CIP Funds, or using some Surplus funds that may be available from the General Budget.
- Rich H reported that the First Selectman would like to see us move forward on collecting estimates/bids for milling the surface and repairing the tennis courts. Todd H volunteered to step up and work on this project.

New Business

- \* Rich H reported that the little storage building on the school side, originally moved from Constant Bros Field on the top of Rte 32, has lost a significant portion of its roof in a recent wind storm. It is beyond repairing at this point. A small shed with a ramp to accommodate an old tractor to be used for dragging the track and softball field is now a necessity, rather than a desire. The first selectman is aware of this and was going to reach out to a particular resident to get an estimate to build one. Greg B offered to reach out to a contact at Norwich Tech to see if this could be a project for the carpentry shop.
- Rich H offered a proposed Meeting Schedule for 2020 as needed by the Town Clerk. After verifying its workability Todd H motioned to approve the Meeting Schedule as proposed. The Motion was seconded by Steve A and passed without dissent.
